Pensions Scholarship Trust grants €5,000 for research on impact of pension funds on companies invested in

The Pensions Scholarship Trust has made a full grant of €5,000 to David Pinkus, in connection with his PhD studies and research at the Copenhagen Business School in Denmark.

The focus of his project is the impact of pension funds on the productivity and innovation of the companies they invest in.

"In this project, I believe the results will provide evidence on the contribution of pension funds' investments to economic growth and will inform policymakers about the importance of such investments for the economy at large," Pinkus says.

Supporting his application to the PST, his supervisor Professor Dario Pozzoli of the Copenhagen Business School, says the findings will be based on company data and provide evidence on pension funds' contribution to economic growth as well as providing clear policy messages.

The award will be used mainly for supporting the research aspects, in particular funding the processing of additional statistical data and the acquisition of new data.

The Pensions Scholarship Trust was set up in 2019 with the purpose of furthering education and research across Europe into the area of pension and retirement income provision. It is the successor to the former IPE Pensions Scholarship Fund.
